Drinking Water Officer, Glen Robertson has advised me that the Eden water system has collected the required re-samples for rescinding the precautionary boil water advisory and that bacteriological testing results meet regulatory standards.

I am therefore rescinding the precautionary boil water advisory that was placed on the Eden water system on November 24, 2017.

Please ensure all water users are notified that the advisory has been rescinded and that normal water usage can be resumed. A copy of this letter can be provided as notification. Notices posted in public locations such as washrooms are to be removed.
