

To all Municipal Residents:

The Rural Municipality of Rosedale is enacting preventative measures aimed to help to slow the spread of COVID-19 and minimize its impact on our health care system and in our community.

The municipal office will remain open to the public. However, we have the following protocols in place to ensure staff and public health and safety:

- If you have travelled or been exposed to the COVID-19 virus in the last 14 days, please do not enter.
- If you have a cough or flu-like symptoms, please do not enter.
- Please use the hand sanitizer on the front counter when entering.
- Staff have been instructed to practice safe social distancing when interacting with the public (minimizing prolonged contact of more than 10 minutes or close contact less than two meters/six feet) and would encourage all public accessing their facilities to practice the same.
- Contact with staff will be limited to the front counter only.

We ask that you carefully consider if attending the municipal office is necessary or whether your business can be conducted by phone, email or web service. Our staff will be happy to assist you in any way they can.
