

# JULY 1, 2020 - ROAD ADVISORY

Please be advised that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale declared a State of Local Emergency (SOLE) effective June 29, 2020. The SOLE was declared due to the extensive overland flooding experienced by Rosedale Municipality from excessive rain June 28, 2020 and again on June 30, 2020. EXTREME CAUTION SHOULD BE EXERCISED BY ALL PERSONS TRAVELLING ON ROSEDALE MUNICIPAL ROADS. The Rural Municipality of Rosedale advises all non-essential travel should be avoided due to the danger of new road washouts and all motorists should avoid travel on all non-paved roads within the R.M. of Rosedale. R.M. of Rosedale roads should be used by local residents only. Avoid driving on roads submerged in water as the road surface underneath may be unstable. The condition of roads is uncertain and currently being evaluated for potential undermining of road surfaces.

Be prepared in case electricity, telephone, or water services are disrupted. Please consult the Government of Canada's guide, "Severe Storms - What to Do?"
