

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE

By-law No. 6-2022

BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING REMUNERATION AND INDEMNITIES PAYABLE TO THE REEVE AND MEMBERS OF COUNCIL.

WHEREAS Section 124(2) of The Municipal Act, C.C.S.M., c.M225, provides as follows:

124(2) A council may by by-law set the types, rates and conditions of payment to be made to or on behalf of members of the council and council committees, other than the committee of a local urban district,

- a) as compensation for attending to municipal business;
- b) for expenses incurred while attending to municipal business; and
- c) for any other purpose relating to municipal business that the council considers appropriate.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the best interests of the residents of The Rural Municipality of Rosedale to provide for the payment of indemnities, mileage and other remuneration for the fulfilment of such duties as a member of council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosedale enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** remuneration of members of Council shall be as follows:

a) **Reeve and Council**

That the Reeve receive an indemnity of \$750.00 per month and each Councillor receive an indemnity of \$700.00 per month for the time spent by him/her performing duties in connection with the carryout of the business, affairs and matters of the municipality in addition to \$15.00 per regular meeting as a lunch allowance.

b) **Mileage**

That all members of Council shall be paid a rate per kilometer equivalent to the rate set by the National Joint Council for the Province of Manitoba, each way from their place of residence to the place of meeting. The minimum mileage compensation shall be set at Five Dollars (\$5.00).

c) **Cell Phone Allowance**

That each Councillor and the Reeve shall receive an indemnity of \$50.00 per month as a cellular telephone allowance.

d) **Organizational Meeting**

That the organizational meeting of Council in any year shall be, for the purpose of this by-law, an additional regular meeting and the Reeve and Council members shall be paid the same as they are paid for a regular monthly meeting.

e) **Special Meetings**

That each member of Council duly authorized to attend a special meeting on behalf of the municipality in the performance of the duties of his/her office shall be paid an additional remuneration of a minimum of \$50.00 for any special meeting attended and for more than 2 hours receive a rate of \$20.00 per hour for a total of \$160.00 per 8-hour day; in addition to up to

Breakfast – Ten Dollars (\$10.00)
Lunch – Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
Supper – Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)

f) **Convention**

That each member of Council attending the annual Municipal Convention be compensated Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per hour to a maximum daily rate of One Hundred and Sixty Dollars (\$160.00). Travel time will be in addition to the hourly rate on the days travelling to the Convention and departing from the Convention. Mileage will be paid in accordance with section b); meal allowance as noted under section e) with the exception of the gala ticket which will be covered and replace the supper meal allowance for those who attend; parking fees and transportation (taxi, etc.) reimbursed upon receipt provided; lodgings will be provided by the municipality.

g) **Computer**

That each member of Council receives a payment of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) once per term for the purpose of maintaining or purchasing a computerized device (such as laptop, tablet or iPad) to be used for municipal meetings and correspondence.

h) **Payments**


That members of council shall at their regular meeting of council, submit an account for monthly, daily and hourly compensation and expenses for their attendance at meetings in the previous month. Such account shall specify the date of the meeting, the type of meeting, its general purpose, the travelling expense incurred, complete with receipts as required, and such account for compensations and expenses shall be verified under statutory declaration and signed by the member of council, and submitted to the Chief Administrative Officer.

That the Signing Officers of the municipality shall not pay out any claim or accounts for compensation or expenses to members of council unless duly approved by Council.

2. **THAT** By-Law 5-2021 be repealed as the date on which this By-law comes into effect.
